Issuance of an exemption certificate shall not create Liability on the part of the Town of Bartonville, the Town Engineer or any officer or employee of the Town of Bartonville in the event flooding or flood damage does occur. Information that may be required as part of a Development/Grading/Fill Permit Application may include the following:

- (1) Plans showing the location, dimensions, and elevation of existing and proposed structures and proposed landscape alterations and the location of the foregoing in relation to areas of special flood hazard.
- (2) Elevation (in relation to mean sea level), of the lowest floor (including basement) of all new and substantially improved structures;
- (3) A certificate from a registered professional engineer or architect that the nonresidential flood-proofed structure shall meet the flood-proofing criteria;
- (4) Plans showing the extent to which any watercourse or natural drainage will be altered or relocated as a result of proposed development;
- (5) A drainage analysis and a grading plan.
