Policy – Veteran’s Memorial Recognition Program

The Town Council desires to honor Bartonville Veterans who have lost their lives while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States of America. A wall has been dedicated in the lobby at Bartonville Town Hall in honor and memory of Bartonville’s fallen veterans.

Criteria: Plaques will be permitted for those that lost their lives while serving in the armed forces and that were at the time, or had previously been, a Bartonville resident. The 8 x 10 plaque will include a 5 x 7 photo with three lines of print to include the service person’s name, branch of service, and years of service.

To apply, complete an application and submit it along with a copy of the veteran’s DD214, and a color portrait photo, preferably in uniform, (if available) to the Town Administrator or his designee.
