All food and beverage cans must be empty and rinsed clean.
Remove caps and lids from glass containers and discard. All glass must be empty and rinsed clean.
Remove caps and lids from plastic containers and discard. All plastic food and beverage containers must be empty and rinsed clean.

Please DO NOT Recycle These Items:

- Household trash
- Aluminum foil
- Auto/window glass
- Ceramics, china, dishes
- Drink boxes with straws
- Hardcover books
- Light bulbs
- Paper milk & juice cartons
- Plastic grocery bags
- Styrofoam cups, plates, packing peanuts
- Plastic toys
- Waxed paper/food containers
- Yard waste
- Hazardous waste
- Plastic, glass or metal containers that held hazardous materials such as:
• Motor oil, paint, pesticide, weed killer/fertilizer



Trash Collection during Holidays.

Trash will not be collected on these holidays:

- Thanksgiving
- Christmas Day
- New Year's Day

If your trash day falls on one of these days, collection will be delayed for one day the rest of the week.
