

**TOWN OF BARTONVILLE  
ORDINANCE NO. 485-09**

**AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE CREATION OF A CRIME  
CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code, the Crime Control and Prevention District Act (“Act”), authorizes municipalities to create crime control and prevention districts and to levy a sales and use tax for the financing thereof, subject to approval by a majority of the voters at an election; and

**WHEREAS**, the first step in creating a Crime Control and Prevention District, is the adoption of a resolution by the Town Council proposing the District and establishing its boundaries;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BARTONVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.**

The Town Council of the Town of Bartonville hereby proposes the creation of the Town of Bartonville, Texas Crime Control and Prevention District, in accordance with the provisions of the Crime Control and Prevention District Act.

**SECTION 2.**

The boundaries of the proposed District shall correspond to the boundaries of the Town of Bartonville, and as such, the proposed District shall be comprised of the entire Town.

**SECTION 3.**

The proposed District shall have all powers, authority, jurisdiction and obligations prescribed by the Act, including but not limited to the power to levy a sales and use tax pursuant to Section 363.055 of the Act and Section 323.105 of the Texas Tax Code.

**SECTION 4.**

In accordance with the Act, creation of the District hereby proposed, and authorization of the sales and use tax for support of such District shall occur only after approval by vote of the majority of the qualified voters of the Town at an election ordered by the District’s temporary board of directors.

**SECTION 5.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication in the official newspaper.
