**ARTICLE 13.100 PRIVATE WATER WELLS; SEPTIC SYSTEMS
AND IRRIGATION SYSTEMS**

Sec. 13.101 Private Water Wells

- (a) All water wells must be set at least one hundred twenty-five feet (125') from any property line. If a water well is cased with cement slurry, then the property line setback of one hundred twenty-five feet (125') may be decreased at the rate of one-half (1/2) of the total depth of the cement slurry casing. In no event, however, shall any water well that is cased with cement slurry be set closer than fifty feet (50') from any property line. (Ordinance 121A adopted 7/21/94)
- (b) No private water well shall share a common line with the public water system.
- (c) No water well shall be drilled without a permit issued by the town secretary.
- (1) No permit for a private water well shall be issued until a plat of the entire property has been submitted to the town secretary showing the location of the well site in relation to septic tanks and lines and property boundaries. The well site must be located by a suitable stake or marker.
 - (2) An official authorized by the town council shall check the drilling site prior to drilling to verify all measurements shown on the plat.
 - (3) The town council shall establish a schedule of fees and a collection procedure for private water well permits. The schedule of fees may be altered or amended only by the town council.
- (d) --A private water well may serve only one deeded lot of record.
